The Art Alliance is a non-profit organization of more than 300 members. Located at the foot of Mount Nittany in Lemont, it is close to the University Park Campus of Penn State University. Our mission is to serve artists, students, and the art-loving public in Centre County and beyond. We sponsor classes, workshops, exhibits, and sales at 818 Pike Street in Lemont, Pennsylvania.

The Annual Exhibition

The Recycled Art Show is in its twenty-fourth year of inspiring environmental and artistic goals for Central Pennsylvania artists. Entry to the show is not juried and is open to artists of all ages. This is an opportunity for artists to express their concern for the environment and the importance of recycling programs like the one we are fortunate to have in Centre County. For the first time this show will be in our Gallery Downtown, attracting a larger audience and open for most of the month of April. We invite you to look in your garage, basement, and attic and find some interesting materials to recycle into an entry for this exciting show!

Eligible Work

All works must be made primarily from recycled/repurposed materials and adhere to the theme, "Green Is The New Black." Materials found in nature (i.e. rocks, grasses) may be included but may not comprise the majority of materials used. Collaborations are acceptable. School classes and youth groups are encouraged to enter group projects. Each project is considered a single entry with one fee.

Entry Process and Fee

Entry forms must be received at the Art Alliance by Tuesday, March 27 by NOON. This deadline will be strictly enforced. The non-refundable entry fee is \$25. For youth (18 and under) the entry fee is waived. You may enter up to two pieces of artwork.

Show Dates and Hours

The exhibit will open with a reception from 5-8pm on Friday, April 6, and will run through April 29. The Gallery Downtown will be open Thursdays-Saturdays 12-6pm and Sundays 12-4pm. Sitters are needed during these times and we will contact you by email to sign up.

Opening Reception

The opening reception will be held Friday, April 6, from 5-8pm. The awards ceremony is scheduled for 7pm. The public is invited and attendees are encouraged to dress or accessorize according to the show's theme.

Dropping Off and Retrieving Work

Work must be delivered to the Art Alliance Gallery Downtown, 123 S. Fraser Street, State College, on Tuesday, April 3 from 4-6pm. All entries must be pre-registered, no on-site entries permitted. All artwork must be picked up on Sunday, April 29, 4-6pm unless you are participating in the extended show (see below).

Extended Show

The juror will select from wall-hung and tabletop pieces to be included in an extended show, displayed inside wall cases at the Centre County Recycling & Refuse Authority, 253 Transfer Road. Dates are April 30 – May 30. If you do not want your piece considered please indicate this on the entry form.
